

Remuneration for SPG events



Definition

The SPG has allocated funds to pay students and qualified physiotherapists to work at events. These events must be highly visible and used as promotion of the profession. The aim of these allocations are to help physios to be more involved with events and be seen as actively involved in sports, not just reacting to injuries when presented at the practice.

Payment structure

Description	Qualified Physio	Student*
Events up to 5 hours	R500 excl VAT	R220 excl VAT
Events over 10 hours	R1000 excl VAT	R220 excl VAT
Hourly fee	R100 excl VAT/hour up until a maximum of R1000	R220 excl VAT

- Students may not be paid to perform physiotherapy services and may only be given a stipend to cover costs and accommodation.

How do I apply

Proposals to the GEC must be received well in advance (more than 30 days) and should include:

- a detailed description of the event
- why this will promote the profession
- why you are applying for funds
- budget

Who does not qualify

- events where a practice or individual is contracted to provide the physiotherapy services
- events where the organizers has allocated funds to cover the costs of physio services
- however, each proposal will be looked at and judged on merit
